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PROCEDURAL CASE HISTORY

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The Bank Commissioner issued a Notice of Hearing - Order to Show Cause, Cease and Desist Order ("Notice of Hearing") against all Respondents on April 4, 2007. The Notice of Hearing derived from the Order to Show Cause With Immediate Suspension and Cease and Desist Order ("Order to Show Cause") issued by the Bank Commissioner against all Respondents on April 3, 2007. The Order to Show Cause incorporates the April 2, 2007 Staff Petition issued by New Hampshire Banking Department Staff Attorney James Shepard.

The adjudicative hearing was originally to be held on Friday, April 13, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. at the New Hampshire Banking Department, located at 64B Old Suncook Road, Concord, New Hampshire 03301. Respondents, having filed a Motion for Continuance of Hearing in this matter (with New Hampshire Banking Department consent), were granted a continuance of the hearing on April 11,

As to Respondents Southstar Funding LLC and Kirk Smith, the Presiding Officer recessed the hearing until Friday, May 18, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. Due to unavailability of the Presiding Officer on May 18, 2007, the hearing was again recessed until Friday, May 25, 2007 at 10:00 a.m.

Staff Attorney James Shepard indicated Respondent Kirk Smith had signed a Consent Agreement with the New Hampshire Banking Department. However, Southstar Funding LLC failed to appear at the adjudicative proceeding.

APPLICABLE RULE OF ADJUDICATORY PROCEEDINGS

Failure of a licensee to appear in person or by representative at the adjudicative proceeding shall constitute a default. New Hampshire $Administrative \ Rule \ BAN \ 204.14 \ (a) \ .$

Further, New Hampshire Administrative Rule BAN 204.14 (b) provides:

- (b) A default for failure to appear shall constitute:
 - (1) A waiver of the licensee's right to an adjudicative proceeding;
 - (2) Admission of the facts alleged; and
 - (3) Consent to the department's determination on the matter.

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1	Finally, a consent agreement signed by Respondent negates the need for
2	a hearing. New Hampshire Administrative Model Rule Jus 810.01. Therefore, a
3	final order is unnecessary as to Respondent Kirk Smith.
4	FINAL ORDER
5	It is hereby ORDERED, that:
6	1. By operation of law, a Default Judgment was entered against Defaulting
	Respondent Southstar Funding LLC on May 25, 2007;
7	2. By operation of law, Defaulting Respondents have waived its rights to
8	an adjudicative proceeding;
9	3. By operation of law, the default shall constitute an admission of the
LO	facts alleged in the Order to Show Cause dated April 3, 2007 and herein
11	incorporate by reference an admission of the allegations contained in
12	the April 2, 2007 Staff Petition, including
L3	a. failure to maintain the financial integrity necessary to warrant
L4	the public confidence;
L5	b. failure to fund outstanding loan commitments; and
16	c. failure to respond to regulatory hearings; and
L7	4. By operation of law, the Defaulting Respondents hereby consents to the
18	New Hampshire Banking Department's determination on the matter as
	follows:
L9	a. Defaulting Respondent's license is hereby revoked; and
20	b. Defaulting Respondent shall hereby pay an administrative fine of
21	\$2,500 for each violation of Chapter 397-A, for a total of
22	\$7,500.00.
