

ORDER

A hearing in this matter was held on March 8, 2011 at the New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department"). The Department was represented by Hearings Examiner Maryam Torben Desfosses. Mr. Richard D. Northrop attended the hearing on behalf of Capitol Mortgage Company Inc (d/b/a CMCI), and Richard D. Northrop (collectively "Respondents"). Mr. Northrop had been provided and had in his possession the Notice of Hearing. Mr. Northrop had previously been provided, but did not bring with him, the Order to Show Cause and Staff Petition. A copy was provided to him at the hearing.

Attorney John T. Lyons of Burlington, Massachusetts had filed a pleading on behalf of the Respondents on February 28, 2010. Attorney Lyons has taken no other action and was not present at the hearing. Mr. Northrop

has an MBA from Boston University and elected to waive representation by counsel. He appeared for Respondents.

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Mr. Northrop admitted the facts alleged in the Notice of Hearing and the Order to Show Cause, including the Staff Petition. The procedural history and factual allegations are set out in those documents and are incorporated into this order.

At the outset of the hearing, the Department withdrew its request for \$7,500.00 in administrative fines against Mr. Northrop. Mr. Northrop agreed to this withdrawal. The Request to withdraw \$7,500.00 in administrative fines against Mr. Northrop is HEREBY GRANTED.

The Department continues to seek from the Respondents:

- 1. An examination fee in the amount of \$1,895.45 (RSA 397-A:12, V);
- 2. A fine for late filing of examination materials in the amount of \$3,750.00 (RSA 397-A:11, II); and
- 3. A fine for late filing of the 2008 Annual Report in the amount of \$1,775.00 (RSA 397-A:13, IV).

The Department's request for payment of these amounts is GRANTED. The Respondents are ordered to pay these amounts upon receipt of this Order.

The Department's request for a penalty against Respondent Capitol Mortgage Company Inc $(d/b/a \ CMCI)$ in the amount of \$7,500.00 is also GRANTED

1	provided, however, the Department has the discretion to waive all or a
2	portion of this penalty.
3	The Respondents surrendered their Department licenses. At the
4	hearing, the Department noted on the record that it was not seeking
5	revocation of these licenses.
