- 7. Each party has the right to have an attorney present to represent the party at the party's expense, or may represent itself or himself. If the Remaining Respondents elect to be represented by Counsel, said Counsel shall file a notice of appearance at the earliest possible date.
- 8. Raef J. Granger, Esq., Hearings Examiner, New Hampshire Banking Department is designated as Hearings Examiner in this matter with authority to represent the public interest within the scope of the Department's authority. The Hearings Examiner shall have the status of a party to this proceeding.
- 9. A Presiding Officer will be delegated to preside over this matter pursuant to RSA 383:7-a and see also RSA 541-A:1, XV.

- 10. Any proposed exhibits shall be pre-marked, for identification only, and filed with the Department and provided to the opposing party five (5) days prior to the Hearing, on June 16, 2011. The Hearings Examiner shall pre-mark the Department's exhibits with Arabic numbers. The Remaining Respondents shall pre-mark exhibits with capital letters. An index/list of exhibits providing a brief description of each exhibit with its corresponding pre-marked number or letter shall be filed by both parties simultaneous with the filing of exhibits.
- 11. The parties shall exchange a list of all exhibits and witnesses to be called at the hearing with a brief summary at the hearing, and shall at the same time file a copy of their respective lists with the Presiding Officer.
