- 13. All periods referenced in this notice shall be calendar days. If the last day of the period so computed falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, then the time period shall be extended to include the first business day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.
- 14. The Department shall have the burden of setting forth a *prima facie* case, then the Respondent shall have the burden of showing compliance with applicable law by a preponderance of the evidence.
- 15. Any Respondent's failure to appear at the time, date, and place specified may result in the hearing being held in absentia and/or default ruling in favor of the Department, without further notice or opportunity to be heard.

- 17. Each party has the right to have the Department provide a certified shorthand court reporter at the requesting party's expense. Any such request shall be submitted in writing to the Presiding Officer at least 10 days prior to the hearing.
 - 18. All documents shall be filed with the Presiding Officer in the form of an original and one (1) copy and shall bear a certification that a copy is being delivered to Hearings Examiner and any other parties to this matter in accordance with applicable laws.
