8 Default Judgment

9 The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department  
 10 ("Department") issued an Order to Cease and Desist ("Order") against  
 11 Respondent 7 Day Loans (d/b/a 7dayloans.com) ("Respondent 7Day") on May 7,  
 12 2012 via Registered Mail. Respondent 7Day's counsel received the Order at  
 13 counsel's Ottawa, Ontario, Canada address on May 16, 2012. Respondent 7Day  
 14 failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or  
 15 before June 15, 2012 (which is thirty days from the May 16, 2012 delivery  
 16 date) as required to avoid Default.

17 It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 18 1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondent
- 19 7Day on June 16, 2012;
- 20 2. The allegations contained in the May 7, 2012 Order to Cease and Desist
- 21 are hereby deemed true;
- 22 3. Respondent 7Day shall immediately pay to the Department an
- 23 administrative fine in the amount of \$2,500.00.
