Respondents received the Order on November 5, 2012 at the St. Johns, Florida address. Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before December 5, 2012 (which is thirty days from the November 5, 2012 delivery date) as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- 1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondents on December 11, 2012;
- 2. The allegations contained in the October 26, 2012
 Order are hereby deemed true; and
- 3. Respondents shall each immediately pay to the Department an administrative fine in the amount of \$5,000.00.
