Kudalis 8 Respondent 9 10 11 NOTICE OF HEARING ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE 12 1. The State of New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") issued to 13 James S. Kudalis ("Respondent") an Order to Show Cause ("Order") on December 14 12, 2014. RSA Chapter 541-A and RSA Chapter 361-A require the Respondent to request a hearing within 30 calendar days of receipt of such order. Upon 15 16 receipt of such request, the Department must schedule a hearing on such matter within ten (10) days unless otherwise waived by the Respondent. 17 18 2. Respondent failed to file a timely request for hearing and on January 21, 19 2015, the Department issued an Entry of Default Judgment. 20 3. Subsequently, the parties entered into settlement negotiations with an 21 anticipated resolution date of February 6, 2015. Accordingly, on January 22 30, 2015, the Department issued an Order Removing Default Judgment. 23 4. Negotiations between the parties did not resolve by the agreed upon 24 date; and therefore, 25 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1 | 5. Respondents shall appear before the Department on Thursday, February 26,
- 2 | 2015 at 10 a.m., at the New Hampshire Banking Department located at 53
- 3 | Regional Drive, Suite 200, Concord, New Hampshire 03301, for the purpose of
- 4 | participating in an adjudicative proceeding. The Department shall bear the
- 5 | burden of proving the truth of the legal and factual allegations in the
- 6 Order by a preponderance of the evidence.
- 7 | The Respondents will have the opportunity to demonstrate why the relief
- 8 | sought in the Order to Show Cause should not become permanent. RSA 541-A;
- 9 || Jus 812.02.
- 10 | 6. Pursuant to RSA 541-A, the legal authorities under which the hearing is
- 11 | to be held are: RSA 541-A, RSA 397-A.
- 12 | 7. Each party has the right to have an attorney present to represent the
- 13 | party at the party's expense, or may represent itself or himself. If the
- 14 | Respondents elect to be represented by Counsel, said Counsel shall file a
- 15 | notice of appearance at the earliest possible date.
- 16 | 8. The Commissioner of the Department has designated a Presiding Officer in
- 17 | this matter with authority to represent the public interest within the scope
- 18 of the Department's authority. The Presiding Officer shall have the
- 19 | authority to preside over the proceeding and exercise the powers, duties or
- 20 | functions delineated in the delegation dated June 17, 2014. RSA 383:7-a; RSA
- 21 | 541-A:1, XIV.
- 22 | 9. The designated Presiding Officer is Stephen J. Judge, Esq. partner in the
- 23 | firm of Wadleigh, Starr & Peters, PLLC, Manchester, NH.
- 24 | 10. Two copies of proposed exhibits shall be pre-marked, for identification
- 25 only, and filed with the staff of the Presiding Officer and a single copy of

- exhibits provided to the opposing party by Wednesday, February 25, 2015. The Department shall pre-mark its exhibits with Arabic numbers. The Respondents shall pre-mark exhibits with capital letters. An index/list of exhibits providing a brief description of each exhibit with its corresponding pre-marked number or letter shall be filed by both parties simultaneous with the filing of exhibits.
- 7 | 11. On the date identified in paragraph 9, the parties shall also exchange a 8 | list of all witnesses to be called at the hearing with a brief summary of the anticipated testimony and shall at the same time file two copies of their respective lists with the staff of the Presiding Officer.
- 12. Notwithstanding the provisions in paragraph 17 exhibit lists and witness
  12 lists may be filed via electronic or facsimile transmission.
  - 13. All periods referenced in this notice shall be calendar days. If the last day of the period so computed falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, then the time period shall be extended to include the first business day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.
    - 14. Respondent's failure to appear at the time, date, and place specified may result in the hearing being held *in absentia* and/or a default ruling in favor of the Department, without further notice or opportunity to be heard.
- 21 | 15. The entirety of all verbal proceedings shall be recorded verbatim by the
  22 | Department. Upon request of any party, such record shall be transcribed by a
  23 | certified court reporter designated by the Presiding Officer, with all costs
  24 | borne solely by the requesting party. The Presiding Officer has discretion

- 1 to order transcription of the record and to determine how the costs shall be 2 borne.
- 3 | 16. Each party has the right to have the Department provide a certified 4 | shorthand court reporter at the requesting party's expense. Any such request 5 | shall be submitted in writing to the Presiding Officer at least 7 days prior
- 6 | to the hearing.
- 7 | 17. All documents shall be filed with the staff of the Presiding Officer in
- 8 the form of an original and one (1) copy and shall bear a certification that
- 9 a copy is being delivered to Hearings Examiner and any other parties to this
- 10 | matter in accordance with applicable laws. All documents shall be filed by
- 11 | mailing or delivering them to the New Hampshire Banking Department, ATTN:
- 12 | Presiding Officer Dkt # 13-413, 53 Regional Drive, Suite 200, Concord, NH
- 13 | 03301. Filing by facsimile or electronic transmission shall not be accepted.
- 14 | 18. The parties may submit Proposed Orders, which shall include findings of
- 15 | fact and conclusions of law, separately stated, no later than ten (10) days
- 16 | following conclusion of the hearing(s) in this matter or at a time set by the
- 17 | Presiding Officer.
- 18 | 19. Routine procedural inquiries may be made by telephoning the
- 19 staff of the Presiding Officer at (603)271-3561 or emailing the staff at
- 20 doreen.sheppard@banking.state.nh.us. All other communications with the
- 21 | Presiding Officer and with the Department shall be in writing and shall be
- 22 | filed as provided above. Ex parte communications are forbidden by statute.
- 23 | 20. A copy of this Notice of Hearing shall be emailed and mailed to the
- 24 | named Respondent and a copy shall also be delivered to the Department.
