NOLLE PROSEQUI

Now comes the State of New Hampshire Bank Commissioner entering a nolle prosequi on all allegations in the Order to Show Cause and the Supplement to the Order to Show Cause in the above-captioned matter.

The Department issued an Order to Show Cause against the Respondent White Mountain Carriage Company, LLC d/b/a Suzuki of Manchester and d/b/a Gold Street Autocenter and Respondent Arrien L.C. Schiltkamp (collectively, “Respondents”) on June 26, 2015. On July 23, 2015, the Respondents timely filed a request for a hearing and worked with the Department in providing consumer restitution to those whose motor vehicles trade-ins still had outstanding liens.

The Respondents ceased conducting business shortly thereafter. On November 13, 2015, the Department issued a Supplement to the Order to Show Cause regarding Respondents’ failure to surrender their New Hampshire Retail Seller license after ceasing to conduct business.

The Department is exercising its authority to enter a *nolle prosequi* as a prosecuting officer acting in the name of the State of New Hampshire to enter a *nolle prosequi* in this matter. *See In Re Stephen O. Dell, M.D.*, 140 N.H. 484, 489 (1995); *State v. Smith*, 49 N.H. 155, 157 (1870).

Accordingly, the Order to Show Cause and the Supplement to the Order to Show Cause in the above-captioned matter are discharged and the matter is no longer pending. *See State v. Coolidge*, 109 N.H. 426, 427 (1969).
