## State of New Hampshire Banking Department

## Default Judgment

The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause against Respondent Genisys Financial Corp ("Respondent Genisys") and Respondent Lawrence A. MacDonald ("Respondent MacDonald") (collectively hereinafter "Respondents") on July 7, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt requested. The Order to Show Cause was returned to the Department on July 13, 2009 and the Commissioner took service on August 24, 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days from August 24, 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the The Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before September 23, 2009 (which is thirty days from August 24, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

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- By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondents on September 23, 2009; and
- The allegations contained in the January July 13, 2009 Order to Show Cause are hereby deemed true; and

1	3. Respondent Genisys shall immediately pay to the Department ar
2	administrative fine for a violation of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount
3	of \$2,500.00; and
4	4. Respondent MacDonald shall immediately pay to the Department ar
5	administrative fine for a violation of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount
6	of \$2,500.00; and
7	5. Respondent Genisys shall immediately pay to the Department the fine
8	for \$2,250.00 for the late filing of the financial statement;
9	6. Each of the above named Respondents shall be jointly and severally
10	liable; and
11	7. Respondent Genisys's license is hereby revoked.
