## State of New Hampshire Banking Department

## Default Judgment

The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause ("Order") against Respondent Equistar Financial Corporation ("Respondent Equistar") and Respondent William Christophe Losch ("Respondent Losch") (collectively hereinafter "Respondents") on July 14, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt The Order to Show Cause was returned to the Department on July 21, 2009 and the Commissioner took service on August 25, 2009. Respondents had thirty (30) days from August 25, 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. The Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before September 24, 2009 (which is thirty days from August 25, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

 By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondents on September 24, 2009; and
