Respondent Mortgage Lenders Network USA Inc. (MLN) was issued an Order to Show Cause and Cease and Desist Order on January 19, 2007. 17 2. Respondents Heffernon and Pedrick were named individually pursuant to 18 RSA 397-A:21. 19 3. On February 5, 2007 Respondent MLN filed a Chapter 11 Bankruptcy 20 Petition in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of 21 Delaware. 22 23 The staff of the Banking Department, State of New Hampshire alleges the 24 following issues of law: 25

- 1. Section 362 of the Bankruptcy Code grants an automatic stay of actions involving the petitioner "including the issuance or employment of process, of a judicial, administrative, or other action or proceeding against the debtor that was or could have been commenced before the commencement of the case under this title, or to recover a claim against the debtor that arose before the commencement of the case under this title."
- 2. The Bankruptcy code is silent as to the continuation of regulatory or other action that arises against individuals in the petitioner's employment who have not themselves submitted a Bankruptcy petition.

RELIEF REQUESTED

The staff of the Banking Department requests the Commissioner take the following action:

- 1. Find as fact the allegations contained in section I; and
- 2. Make conclusions of law relative to the allegations contained in section II; and
- 3. Stay the previously issued order consistent with the provisions of §362 of the Bankruptcy code against Respondent MLN only; and
- 4. Schedule a hearing after request for one is made for Respondents

 Heffernon and Pedrick or find them in default on expiration of the time

 period in the original notice; and
- 5. Take such other administrative and legal actions as are necessary for enforcement of the New Hampshire Banking laws, the protection of New Hampshire citizens, and to provide other equitable relief.
