The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause against the Respondent Manhattan Financial Services, Inc. ("Respondent") on May 8, 2007 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt requested. The Order to Show Cause was returned to the Department on May 30, 2007 and the Commissioner took service on July 9, 2009. The Respondent had thirty (30) days from July 9, 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. The Respondent failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before August 8, 2009 (which is thirty days from July 9, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondent on August 9, 2009;
- 2. The allegations contained in the May 8, 2007 Order to Show Cause are hereby deemed true;

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1	3. Respondent shall immediately pay to the Department an administrativ
2	fine for a violation of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount of \$2,500.00;
3	4. Respondent shall immediately pay to the Department the outstanding
4	exam invoice totaling \$635.00;
5	5. Each of the above named Respondents shall be jointly and severall
6	liable; and
7	6. Respondent's license is hereby revoked.
