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## CONSENT ORDER

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- For purposes of settling the above-referenced matter, among other things, the New Hampshire Banking Department (hereinafter referred to as "the Department") and Respondents, do hereby enter this Agreement and stipulate to the following:
  - 1. The Respondents are licensed to conduct mortgage banking activity by the Department pursuant to RSA 397-A:3.

- 2. The Respondents' primary business is located in Centerville, Virginia. The Respondents have branch locations in the state of New Hampshire.
- 3. The Department began an examination of Respondent entity on March 12, 2007.
- 4. During the examination the Respondents refused to grant access to certain books and records of the business.
- 5. The Commissioner subsequently issued an Order to Show Cause with Immediate Suspension and a Cease and Desist Order to Respondents.

- 6. The Respondents have substantially complied with examination requests thereafter.
- 7. The Respondent does not admit that it has committed any violation of New Hampshire Banking Laws or Regulations but wishes to avoid further formal process.
- II. For purposes of amicably resolving and closing the above-referenced matters the Respondent agrees to the following terms and conditions and the Department accepts the same:
  - 1. The Respondents agree that they have voluntarily entered into this Agreement without reliance upon any discussions between the Department and Respondent, without promise of a benefit of any kind (other than concessions contained in this Agreement), and without threats, force, intimidation, or coercion of any kind. The Respondent further acknowledges its understanding of the nature of the offenses stated above, including the penalties provided by law.
  - 2. The Respondents agree to waive any and all rights to a hearing and appeal thereof.
  - 3. The Respondents agree that they will not deny the factual basis for this Agreement to which they have stipulated above and will not give conflicting statements about such facts or their involvement in the stipulated facts.
  - 4. The Respondents agree that all terms of this Agreement are contractual and none is a mere recital.
  - 5. The Respondents will immediately pay a fine for violation of RSA 399-A:12 in the amount of \$3,000.
  - 6. The Respondents acknowledge they are jointly and severally liable for such payment.
  - 7. The Respondent acknowledges that failure to make payment as agreed above or further violations of law will result in license action and additional administrative fines.
  - 8. Each person who signs this Consent Order in a representative capacity warrants that his or her execution of this Consent Order is duly authorized, executed, and delivered by and for the entity for which he signs.

This Agreement represents the complete and final resolution of, and discharge of any basis for any civil or administrative proceeding by the Department against the Respondent for violations arising as a result of or in connection with any actions or omissions by the Respondent through the date of this Order as it applies to the allegation of Failure to Facilitate an Examination; provided, however, this release does not apply to facts not known by the Department or not otherwise provided by the Respondent to the Department as of the date of this Order nor does it prohibit the Department from taking action as a result of the Examination currently ongoing. The Department expressly reserves its right to pursue any administrative or civil action or remedy available to it should the Respondent breach this Agreement or in the future violate the Act or rules and orders promulgated thereunder.
