## Order on Motion to Strike Default Judgment

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY

An Order to Show Cause was issued against the Respondent on November 16, 2007. The Respondent received and signed for the Order on November 21, 2007. The Respondent failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department within thirty days as required to avoid Default. By operation of law default judgment was entered on December 21, 2007. By Order dated January 30, 2008 the allegations contained in the Staff Petition of November 16, 2007 were deemed true. The Respondent timely moved to strike the default judgment.

## JUDGMENT OF THE COMMISSIONER

Having read and considered the previous orders, the Respondent's letter, which can reasonably be construed as a motion to strike the default judgment, and the Staff's response thereto, it is hereby ordered:

- 1. The Motion to Strike the Default Judgment is DENIED; and
- 2. The Default Judgment issued on January 30, 2008 is affirmed; and ORDER
