State of New Hampshire Banking Department

Default Judgment

The Commissioner issued Cease and Desist Order against the Respondents on July 30, 2007. The Respondents received and signed for the Order on August 4, 2007. The Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department within thirty days as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

- By operation of law, default judgment was entered against Respondents on September 4, 2007; and
- 2. The allegations contained in the Cease and Desist Order dated July 30, 2007 are deemed true; and
- 3. Respondent Gulfstream shall immediately pay to the Department administrative fines for violation of Chapter 397-A (\$2,500.00); and
- 4. Respondent Schweitzer shall immediately pay to the Department administrative fines for violation of Chapter 397-A (\$2,500.00); and
- 5. The Respondents shall repay to consumers all commissions collected as a result of their unlicensed activity said sum being \$3,157.40.
