5	3. Respondent Back Bay, Inc. shall immediately pay to the Department an
6	administrative fine in the amount of \$75,000.00;
7	4. Respondent Mulligan shall immediately pay to the Department an
8	administrative fine in the amount of \$77,500.00;
9	5. Respondent Miller shall immediately pay to the Department an
10	administrative fine in the amount of \$60,000.00;
11	6. Respondents shall immediately pay to the Department the outstanding
12	examination invoice totaling \$1,311.13;
13	7. Respondents shall immediately pay to the Department the statutory sum
14	of \$775.00 for the late filing of the financial statement;
15	8. Respondents shall immediately pay to the Department the accrued
16	statutory sum of \$20,400.00 for the failure to file examination
17	materials;
18	9. Each of the above named Respondents shall be jointly and severally
19	liable for the amounts in Paragraph 3 through 8 above; and
20	10. Respondent Back Bay, Inc.'s license is hereby revoked.
