The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause ("Order") against the Respondents Kingsway Auto Sales - Seabrook, LLC ("Respondent Kingsway - Seabrook") and George Dilorenzo ("Respondent Dilorenzo") on January 30, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt requested. The Order was returned to the Department as "Unclaimed."

The Commissioner accepted service of the Order on behalf of the above named Respondents on March 10, 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days from March 10, 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. The Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before April 9, 2009 (which is thirty days from March 10, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

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- By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondents on April 10, 2009;
- 2. The allegations contained in the Order hereby deemed true;

	3. Respondent kingsway - Seabrook shall immediately pay to the Department
2	an administrative fine in the amount of \$7,500.00;
3	4. Respondent Dilorenzo shall immediately pay to the Department ar
4	administrative fine in the amount of \$12,500.00;
5	5. Respondents shall immediately pay to the Department the outstanding
6	examination invoice totaling \$3,185.00;
7	6. Respondents shall immediately pay to the Department the statutory sum
8	of \$2,500.00 for the failing to file the 2007 annual report;
9	7. Each of the above named Respondents shall be jointly and severally
10	liable for the amounts in Paragraph 3 through 6 above; and
11	8. Respondent Kingsway - Seabrook's license is hereby revoked.
