## State of New Hampshire Banking Department

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## Default Judgment

The Commissioner the Hampshire Banking Department of New ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause ("Order") against Respondent Vermont Allstate Funding, Inc. (d/b/a Vermont Allstate Funding) ("Respondent Allstate Funding"), Respondent Shawn M. Brown ("Respondent S. Brown") and Respondent Robin L. Brown ("Respondent R. Brown") (collectively hereinafter "Respondents") on January 22, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt requested. The Respondents received and signed for the Order on February 3 2009. The Respondents had thirty (30) days from February 3, 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. The individual Respondents' case has been stayed. However, Respondent Allstate Funding failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before March 5, 2009 (which is thirty days from February 3, 2009) as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against

1	Respondent Allstate Funding on March 6, 2009;
2	2. The allegations contained in the January 22, 2009 Order to Show Caus
3	are hereby deemed true;
4	3. Respondent Allstate Funding shall immediately pay to the Department as
5	administrative fine for two (2) violations of RSA Chapter 397-A in the
6	amount of \$5,000.00;
7	4. Respondent Allstate Funding shall immediately pay to the Department
8	the outstanding exam invoice totaling \$1,680.00;
9	5. Respondent Allstate Funding shall immediately pay to the Department
10	\$175.00 for the late filing of the 2007 annual report; and
11	6. Respondent Allstate Funding's license is hereby revoked.
