Default Judgment

The Commissioner of the New Hampshire Banking Department ("Department") issued an Order to Show Cause ("Order") against Respondent Fairfield Financial Mortgage Group Inc (d/b/a FFMGI Mortgage Group) ("Respondent Fairfield Financial"), Respondent Charles L. Levesque ("Respondent C.L. Levesque"), Respondent Lisa A. Levesque ("Respondent L.A. Levesque") and Respondent Randy Hurinker ("Respondent Hurinker") (collectively hereinafter "Respondents") on June 11, 2009 via U.S. Certified Mail Return Receipt requested. The Respondents received and signed for the Order on June 20,2009 . The Respondents had thirty (30) days from June 20 , 2009 to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department. The Respondents failed to request a hearing or reach a settlement with the Department on or before July 20, 2009 (which is thirty days from June 20 , 2009) as required to avoid Default.

It is hereby ORDERED, that:

1. By operation of law, a default judgment was entered against Respondents on July 21, 2009;
2. The allegations contained in the June 11, 2009 Order to Show Cause are hereby deemed true;
3. Respondent Fairfield Financial shall immediately pay to the Department an administrative fine for a violation of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount of $\$ 2,500.00$;
4. Respondent C.L. Levesque shall immediately pay to the Department an administrative fine for two (2) violations of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount of $\$ 5,000.00$;
5. Respondent L.A. Levesque shall immediately pay to the Department an administrative fine for two (2) violations of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount of $\$ 5,000.00$;
6. Respondent Hurinker shall immediately pay to the Department an administrative fine for two (2) violations of RSA Chapter 397-A in the amount of $\$ 5,000.00$;
7. Respondent Fairfield Financial shall immediately pay to the Department the outstanding exam invoice totaling $\$ 2,800.00$;
8. Each of the above named Respondents shall be jointly and severally liable; and
9. Respondent Fairfield Financial's license is hereby revoked.
