



## Checklist for Archaeological Sensitivity Technical Review for Grant Funded Projects

Please provide the following information:

- Physical location/address of the property
- Brief description of property's history and association with site; list any previously known ground disturbances at site (ex., built in 1800, moved in 1860, foundation and drainage repairs in 1930, flowerbeds and foundation plantings installed in 1970, etc.)
- Topographic map of property/site with project identified
- Plan depicting area of ground disturbance (If not available, please provide a written description of the proposed ground disturbance, including depth and horizontal extent of disturbance)
- Photographs of the property/site

Technical reviews are done as a courtesy for grant applications, please allow up to 30 days for review and plan accordingly with the grant application deadlines for the program to which you are applying.
