Hello Tom,

Thank you for taking some time to speak with me earlier today regarding Fat Katz.

I was able to get some clarification regarding the karaoke/open mike performances. If performers are sharing any equipment, this would include microphones or karaoke machines, then Fat Katz cannot allow for any karaoke/open mike performances. If performers bring their own equipment and they are located outside, then you can allow for karaoke/open mine performances. Small group bands and solo music artists are allowed to perform in outdoor areas as long as they can maintain social distance of 6 feet apart from each other and any table.
