Dear Mr. Hursti,

After careful consideration and review, you have been selected as our joint designee to the forensic election audit team established pursuant to the Legislature's Senate Bill 43 ("SB 43").

We have copied the designee chosen by the Town of Windham to this letter. Pursuant to the requirements of SB 43, you and Windham's designee must now jointly select a designee to fill the final member position of the forensic election audit team.

The remaining responsibilities and duties of the forensic election audit team have been outlined by the Legislature in SB 43. The State is establishing the infrastructure for the audit process including securing a venue for the audit, security, a livestreaming process, overnight storage for the ballot counting devices and the ballots, and access for the three groups of individuals designated in SB 43.
