**A Letter from Concerned Citizens of New Durham,**

Are you frustrated with not knowing what is going on in our town government? Are you tired with our increasing taxes and the funding of projects that the residents have voted down, such as, the Boodey Farmhouse project and paying for our GIFT of the Alton Barn!

Are you tired of the secrecy and bullying tactics of Selectboard Chair David Swenson when you ask questions or speak up? Are you amazed at how many "emergency" selectboard meetings have been held in the past 2-3 months? Do you know that 2 of the Selectmen are spending the winter in other, warmer states and illegally zooming into the meetings?

Did you know that in the past 5 years, 90% of town employees have left their positions due to a hostile workplace? The intimidation and bullying of them has occurred under Chair Swenson with the other two Selectmen going along with him.

Did you know that the Selectmen sent scathing letters to the School Board which put in jeopardy the town's possibility to use the New Durham School for elections?

**Rudy Rosiello** is running for the 1-year term. He is retired from a successful career in Professional Accounting and as an Executive in Information Technology. He has led the Information Technology Committee and currently serves on the Budget Committee. When the School Board invited the Selectmen to a School Board meeting on January 10<sup>th</sup>, our Chair David Swenson left town. Rudy chose to attend the meeting along with Fire Chief Varney and others which resulted in the School Board allowing the town to use the school for the March 8<sup>th</sup> election. Rudy Rosiello then went to the SAU office and reviewed communications, and information on the cooperative agreements/policy. Rudy is already hard at work to improve the working relationship between the SAU and the Town. He fully recognizes that the Select Board makes better decisions when the residents are fully informed, involved and working together.

**Marc DeCoff** is running for the 3-year term. He has a Bachelor's degree in business from SNHU. He served for 21 years in the National Guard and retired as a Commander. He started his own business in 2004 and moved it and his home to New Durham a few years ago. While in Alton, he served on the Select Board, the Budget Committee and as a volunteer in the Fire Department in Alton and Kittery, Maine. He coached his daughter's softball team for the Parks and Recreation Department. In New Durham, he serves on the Budget Committee and at the Fire Department. He has much experience working with town government and wants to improve New Durham.

Every year, thousands of votes are lost to voting machines, statewide. Yet, many New Hampshire towns persist in using electronic ballot counting devices.

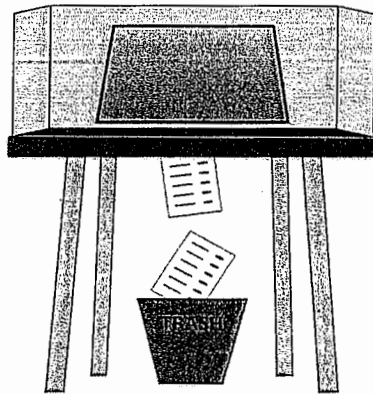
### **NH RECOUNTS UNCOVERED *BIG* MACHINE ERRORS:**

- Somersworth (2016) – over 10% error
- Laconia (2018) – over 2% error
- Windham (2020) – over 6% error
- In State Legislature races *alone*:  
87 errors of over 1/2% – *just since 2016!*

We will never know of errors occurring in towns and for offices not recounted.

It takes only one vote to win or lose a race.
