

We have received the above-referenced requests to revise four (4) projects in the Rockingham MPO <u>FY 2023 Transportation Improvement Program</u> under our Administrative Modifications procedures. The modifications proposed are summarized in the table on page two of this letter and are more fully described in the "2023 TIP Minor Revision Report" for November 2023 which is attached. We concur that these projects changes are eligible for amendment through the Administrative Modification process.

Our TIP Amendment procedures (Section 6.5, MPO <u>Prospectus</u>) allow such modifications by action of the Executive Director provided that no exceptions are raised by MPO members. 
