Training Supports for the OJT Program

Through your New Hampshire Department of Transportation

WHAT IS ON the JOB TRAINING?

On the Job Training (OJT) Program offers equal opportunity for the training and job advancement of women, minorities and other disadvantaged individuals over the age of 18 in the highway construction trades. This Program exists to ensure that a competent workforce is available to meet highway construction hiring needs and to address the historical under-representation of members of these groups in highway construction skilled crafts.



We want to diversify the workforce, provide you with meaningful training, and help you either advance in your current career or find a new career path. A typical On-The-Job Training placement is about 500 hours, and the goal is for you to become a permanent, valued member of the contractor's workforce.

CDL Class B tuition subsidy:

All OJTs qualify for an NHDOT subsidy which pays for **\$2,000 off** a CDL-class B license class—roughly half of the total cost. We also know of other funding sources that may be able to help fund the remaining costs. To qualify you need:

- A valid NH driver's license
- A valid NH CDL-B permit
- A Birth Certificate
- NH Criminal Background Check
- NH Motor Vehicles Record
