



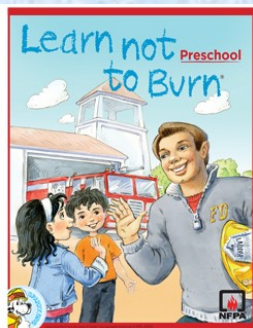

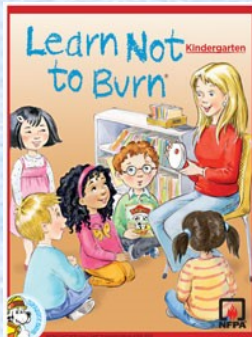

LEARN NOT TO BURN

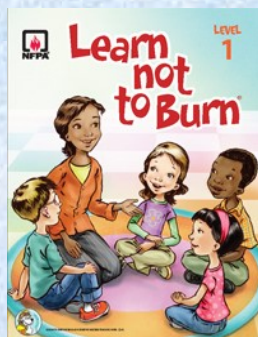

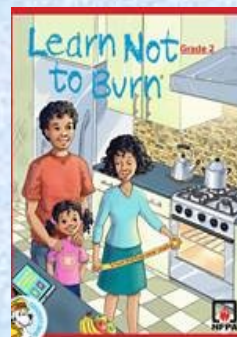
Preschool Program

Grade 2 Program

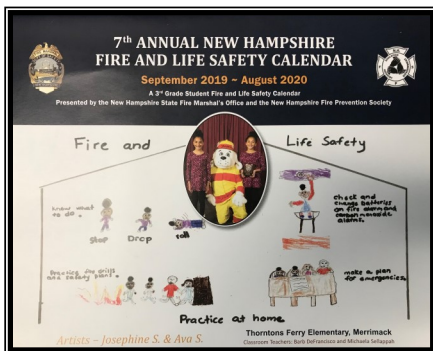
