ORDER ON TRINITY HEALTHSHARE, INC.'S ASSENTED-TO MOTION

TO EXTEND PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER DEADLINE

Trinity Healthshare, Inc. ("Trinity") has filed an Assented-to Motion to Extend

Proposed Scheduling Order Deadline ("Motion"). In the Motion, Trinity requests that the

deadline for the parties to submit a proposed scheduling order be extended. In particular,

Trinity requests that the deadline be extended to seven days after the Merrimack Superior

Court issues an order on the legal claims it is scheduled to hear on August 11, 2020. Trinity

represents that Mary Bleier, Esquire, the Department's Compliance and Enforcement

Counsel, assents to the Motion.

For the reasons set forth in the Motion, I find good cause exists to GRANT Trinity's

the Order issued in this matter on May 26, 2020, include a proposed timeline for rescheduling

the hearing, anticipated preliminary hearings, and filing deadlines.
